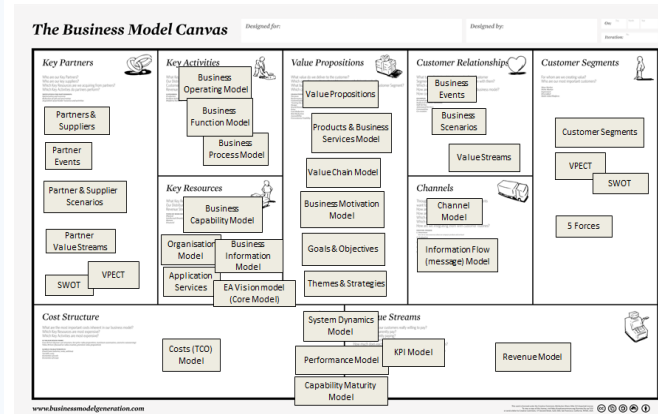
How we deliver this service
